



COVID-19 Guidelines

These requirements relate to all delegates, speakers, contractors and any other staff/volunteers involved in the delivery of the 2022 NSW & VIC Combined Weeds Conference being held at The Albury Entertainment Centre on 21 to 24 March. These requirements may change to adhere to relevant Public Health Order changes.

- Attendees should be fully vaccinated (including booster shot) against COVID-19 prior to travelling to attend the conference.
- Attendees are encouraged to take a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) prior to attending the conference, and only commence travelling on a negative test result.
- Attendees must not attend the conference if they are showing symptoms of COVID-19 including sore throat, cough, fever or runny nose.
- Attendees must not attend the event if they have been advised by NSW Health that they are a close contact of a person diagnosed with COVID-19 in the 7 days prior to the commencement of the conference.
- Attendees will be requested to sanitize hands upon entering all conference rooms and prior to boarding the buses for the field trips.
- Attendees are required to wear masks at all times when participating in indoor conference sessions, events and activities, unless seated, eating or drinking or have an exemption.
- All persons boarding a bus must wear a mask whilst on the bus.
- QR Codes will be displayed in key areas of the event and check in will be required according to current Public Health Orders.
- Social distancing will be enforced according to current Public Health Orders.
